## Generational sparks *–understanding our times*

### Talk and conversation with culture commentator Anne Sophia Hermansen

These years we often talk about how younger and older generations seem to have completely different values. The older generations talk about Work/Life, while the young are more focused on Life/Work. To understand the generations, we need to understand our present time and the undercurrents that shape it.

“We live in a cold time,” Danish singer Kim Larsen sang back in the 1970s, but in the meantime things have become highly heated, and today sparks are flying between the generations. Young people call the older ones boomers, the older call the young “curling kids”, and even small things like gender-neutral cake figures and “Eskimo” ice cream can trigger strong reactions – just as climate change, the conflict between Israel and Palestine, and sexism in the workplace can.

Gain deeper insight into our times together with culture commentator Anne Sophia Hermansen, who for 15 years has interpreted the spirit of the age and been one of Denmark’s most prominent opinion makers.
